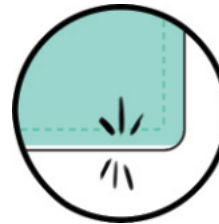


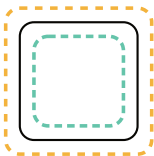
A - Margins

Keep all the important information and artwork inside the margin lines. This way you will avoid losing content if the artwork gets displaced when the paper is cut.



B - Bleed

Remember to always extend your artwork to the bleed lines. If you leave it blank, and because of small displacements during the cutting step, you could end with some white areas showing in the borders.



C - Tokens

Each individual token on the punchboard needs its own margin and bleed. A token's bleed shouldn't overlap with another token's bleed, nor the punchboard's edge bleed.
